



AUBURN CLUB AUTOGRAPH POLICY AND REQUEST

Important Auburn Club Information:

Each chartered Auburn Club in good standing and with an annual scholarship may request one autographed item per calendar year to be used as a fundraising item during club events. The item is purchased by the Auburn club program and reimbursed for the cost of the item and shipping by the club. Please submit request at least six weeks in advance.

Important Auburn Athletics Department Autograph Policy Information:

Auburn's Head Football Coach will be available to sign footballs, helmets or other items at special events throughout the year, including A-Day, Auburn's Spring Football Game, and Fan Day. Time permitting, Auburn's Head Coach will also sign autographs at Auburn Alumni Association Club Meetings.

Due to NCAA rules, we are unable to fulfill any request for autographs from any current student-athlete. It is against NCAA rules for any item signed by a current student-athlete to be auctioned off or used as a part of a fundraiser. If you wish to have a student-athlete autograph an item for your personal use, please attend one of the following special events listed below.

NCAA guidelines request that the following conditions be met in regards to institutional memorabilia and autographs:

1. The requested item may not be used in fundraising events for any high school organization, high school fund raising event that will benefit a charity or educational project or any high school or prospect-aged individual. High school is defined as grades nine through twelve.
2. All monies derived from the promotions activity or project must go directly to the charity, non-profit agency or educational institution listed above.
3. The requested item involving student-athlete's names may not involve co-sponsorship, advertisement or promotion by commercial agency other than a company's logo or trademark on printed materials.
4. An authorized representative of the agency must sign a waiver agreeing to adhere to all NCAA guidelines regarding this request.
5. Use of the memorabilia item must have written approval from the Auburn Athletics Department Compliance Office.
6. Memorabilia may not be re-sold for any purpose without Auburn Athletics Department Compliance approval.

By completing the form below, I confirm my knowledge of the NCAA rules and regulations pertaining to this request and agree to abide by all said guidelines. I understand that Auburn University reserves the right to request the return of memorabilia or autographed items when guidelines are not followed.
