Membership and Philanthropic Expectations

Each council member is required to be a contributing member of the Auburn Alumni Association. This includes being a Life Member or an Annual Member.

Also, council members are expected to make an annual philanthropic gift of *any amount to any* college/school, department, organization or program at Auburn University.

Participation Expectations

Members of the Auburn Alumni Association's Young Alumni Council are volunteers and with the honor to serve also comes the expectation of active engagement and commitment to supporting the goals and mission of the Auburn Alumni Association specially on matters pertaining to young alumni. Therefore, council members are expected to actively participate in all council activities, including council meetings, council teleconference calls and local/regional young alumni programming carried out by the council. Each council member is expected to:

- Miss no more than 2 on-campus council meetings during his/her 2-year term
- Miss no more than 4 bi-monthly council calls during his/her 2-year term
- Actively participate in local/regional young alumni programming carried out by the council where possible
- Actively engage with your local Auburn Club where possible
